RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ALASKA POSTSECONDARY ACCESS AND COMPLETION NETWORK AND STATEWIDE POSTSECONDARY ATTAINMENT GOAL OF "65 BY 2025" (State of Alaska)

WHEREAS, the mission of the Alaska Process Industry Careers Consortium (APICC) is simply to work to ensure the availability of highly trained Alaskans, sufficient to staff process industries competitively in the years to come through partnerships, leadership, awareness and advocacy, and alignment with education institutions and workforce development priorities and initiatives, and

WHEREAS current and future workforce needs require continued education and training to stay competitive; and

WHEREAS, by 2020, the State of Alaska predicts a shortage of more than 22,000 workers with at least some college education, and workforce research shows inadequate supply of industry certifications in the skilled trades, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Alaska Process Industry Careers Consortium Board of Directors supports the Alaska Postsecondary Access & Completion Network in their mission to "Increase the percentage of all Alaskans who complete postsecondary education, particularly credentials relevant to a robust Alaskan economy."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alaska Process Industry Careers Consortium Board of Directors endorses the "65 by 2025" postsecondary attainment goal and intends to actively engage as a Network member organization working to achieve "65 by 2025".
