A highlight of this experience was overseeing the transfer of the Federally controlled P.L. 93-638 school district to the state operated REAA school district of the same name. I'm presently working on two scholarly manuscripts. One on Alaska rural education (Title I is a major part), the other is on family travel and home school research titled: "An Alaskan Family Odyssey: Education on Wheels" ...
