Chuck Seaca (formerly Herman) grew up in Bethel and is now the Youth Programs Manager at the Alaska Humanities Forum. He attended Ayaprun Elitnaurvik (the Yup'ik Immersion elementary school), Bethel Regional High School (BRHS) and then earned a BA in Public Policy and Sociology from Pomona College in California. After college graduation, he joined the Alaska College & Career Advising Corps and moved home to Bethel to serve at BRHS. In his final year as a College and Career Guide, 82% of BRHS seniors completed the FAFSA (as compared to the statewide average of 37%) and the senior class of ≈ 40 was awarded over 1.2 million dollars in scholarships. Chuck then earned a Master's in Public Policy with Distinction from the Harvard Kennedy School and stayed on after graduation to work as a Head Teaching Fellow. He now lives in Anchorage and serves as the Youth Programs Manager at the Alaska Humanities Forum, where he oversees youth programs including Take Wing "Tengluni" and the Rose Cross-Cultural Exchange. Chuck attended the first AlaskaCAN conference in 2015 and has attended every year he has been living in Alaska since. He is passionate about expanding access to education, excited to learn from others across the state who are working to increase postsecondary completion, and hopes to receive your vote to serve on the Board of Directors!
